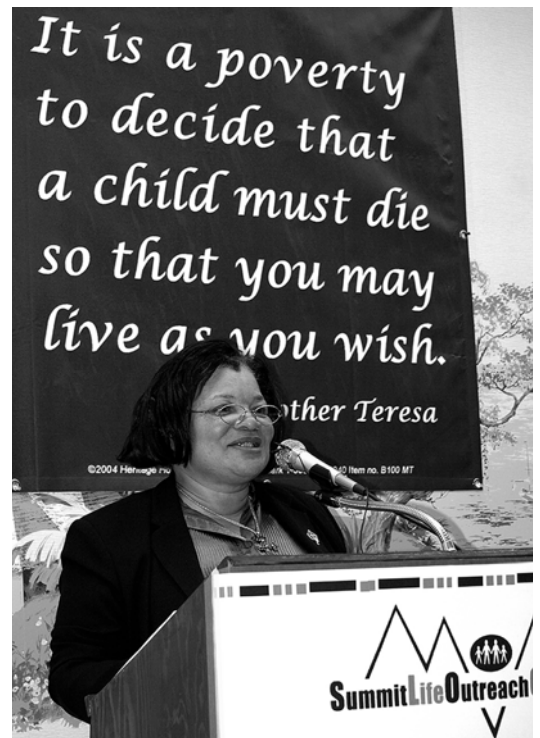
Dr. King Speaks at 2008 Fundraising Banquet

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. once stated, "Injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere." On October 4, 2008, the niece of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., Dr. Alveda C. King, was crying out for justice for the unborn when she spoke at the Second Annual Banquet of the Summit Life Outreach Center at Our Lady of Fatima Shrine in Lewiston, NY. Her passionate words fell heavily on the crowded hall when she said, "I have a dream...but it's not about skin color....We've been lied to on so many fronts."

What were the lies of which Dr. King spoke? She cited many throughout our nation's history. She went on to describe horrible events in history, each of which was "legal" and encouraged the murder and oppression of innocent human beings. She spoke of slavery, how a person's life was entirely determined by another human being, just because that person was of a certain race or skin color. Dr. King stated, "Of one blood, God created everybody...We're all human beings... Slavery was a result of the lie that black people are inferior to white people." She spoke of the Holocaust, the sadistic effort to exterminate the people of a particular faith. In each instance, the victims were seen as inferior and legally defined as such. Dr. King explained that, today, it's no different, that this world faces a new form of slavery, a new horrific holocaust,...that of abortion. She stated that more people have been slaughtered as a result of the legalization of abortion than from all of our nation's wars combined. She stated that the child in the womb is the slave of its mother as she can legally terminate her pregnancy at any point. She stated that it's genocide, as well. She lamented over that fact that "35% of abortions happen to black women." She emphatically stated that her uncle, Dr. Martin Luther King, would never have condoned abortion! "Abortion is not a civil right," she stated.

Dr. King credits her father as being one of the "two strong black men who stopped (her own) cycle of abortion." Dr. King says that "it's not about skin color" now. "The sexual revolution was a disaster, the breakdown of the family." Generations of women have been brainwashed into believing that, because abortion is legal, it must be alright. Dr. King stated that "pro-life is a civil right...based on the fact that you're human." Her father said, "People are more interested in making a living than making a life." Dr. King asks, "Is a woman a sanctuary or a tomb?"

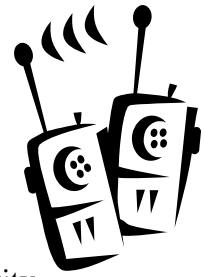

A New Addition to Our Summit Life Family

We'd like to take a moment to introduce the newest member of our Summit Life Family ... Mr. Thomas Moore. Tom has recently joined the Board of Directors at the Center. Tom joins our Summit Life family after recently relocating to Niagara County from Miami, Florida.

Tom has been involved in the pro-life movement since the early 1980's when he and his wife Mary started holding prayer meetings in their home for the local Right to Life group. Shortly after the Moore's began hosting the Right to Life group prayer meetings, Tom started the Miami branch of Catholics United for Life, which is a ministry of the New Hope, Kentucky lay Catholic religious community. This group held monthly rosary prayer meetings, studied pro-life materials, planned sidewalk counseling strategies, and coordinated group members work to save babies. This group was involved in saving several babies in coordination with the local pro-life Catholic clinic.

Tom's background as a psychology professor provides an excellent resource for the Center's team of peer counselors. Tom's expertise and experience is already being put to work through various training and peer counseling sessions.
